

## **CODES OF CONDUCT**

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- Code of Conduct for Glen Iris Scorpions Coaches:
   As a coach within Glen Iris Scorpions Junior Basketball Club, you are expected to adhere to the following principles:
  - Professional Conduct: Conduct yourself with professionalism and integrity at all times, adhering to the standards set forth by Basketball Victoria.
  - Player Development: Prioritise the development of players' skills, knowledge, and understanding of the game, in alignment with <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s emphasis on player growth.
  - Respect for Officials: Show respect towards officials, accepting their decisions and refraining from disputing calls during games, in accordance with <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s policy on sportsmanship.
  - Safe Environment: Ensure the safety and well-being of players by following Basketball Victoria's guidelines for safe training and competition environments.
  - Inclusive Coaching: Foster an inclusive and supportive environment for all players, in line with <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s commitment to diversity and inclusion. Adapt coaching style to support player's with neuro-diversities, disabilities and/or in line with parent feedback.
  - Fair Play: Encourage fair play and sportsmanship among players, emphasising <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s values of honesty and respect.
  - Continuous Learning: Continuously seek opportunities for professional development and growth as a coach, in accordance with <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s emphasis on lifelong learning.
  - Conflict Resolution: Handle conflicts or disagreements with players, parents, or officials in a constructive and respectful manner, following <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s procedures for conflict resolution.
  - Communication: Communicate openly and effectively with players, parents, and club officials, ensuring transparency and clarity in all interactions, as per <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s communication guidelines.
  - Compliance: Ensure compliance with all <u>Basketball Victoria</u> rules, regulations, and policies, upholding the integrity of the sport and the organisation.

- 2. Code of Conduct for **Glen Iris Scorpions Team Managers**:
  As an official in Glen Iris Scorpions Junior Basketball club, you are expected to adhere to the following guidelines:
  - Professionalism: Conduct yourself with professionalism and integrity, demonstrating respect towards players, coaches, and spectators, as outlined in <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s code of conduct for officials.
  - Knowledge of Rules: Maintain a thorough understanding of the rules and regulations of basketball, as required by <u>Basketball</u> <u>Victoria</u>'s officiating standards.
  - Decision Making: Make decisions promptly and decisively during games, applying <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s guidelines for officiating judgement and discretion.
  - Safety Awareness: Prioritise the safety of players by enforcing <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s rules and regulations related to player safety and injury prevention.
  - Conflict Resolution: Manage conflicts or disputes between players, coaches, or spectators in accordance with <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s policies for conflict resolution.
  - Communication: Communicate effectively with players, coaches, and fellow officials, following <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s guidelines for respectful and clear communication.

  - Self-Control: Maintain self-control and composure, even in challenging or frustrating situations, avoiding actions that could harm yourself or others, as outlined in <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s guidelines for player behaviour.
  - Personal Development: Strive for personal improvement and growth as a basketball player, setting goals and working diligently to achieve them, in accordance with <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s commitment to player development.
  - Positive Attitude: Maintain a positive attitude towards practices, games, and challenges, approaching each opportunity with enthusiasm and determination, as emphasised by <u>Basketball</u> <u>Victoria</u>'s focus on player attitude and mindset.
  - Communication: Communicate openly and respectfully with coaches and teammates, expressing concerns or ideas in a constructive manner, following <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s guidelines for player communication.

- Represent the Club: Represent the club with pride and honour, both on and off the court, knowing that your behaviour reflects on the entire organisation, as outlined in <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s expectations for player conduct.
- 4. Code of Conduct for **Glen Iris Scorpions Parents and spectators**:
  As a parent of a player in Glen Iris Scorpions Junior Basketball Club, you are expected to follow these guidelines:
  - Supportive Behaviour: Support your child's participation in basketball by attending games and practices regularly, offering encouragement and positive reinforcement, as emphasised by <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s parent involvement policies.
  - Respect for Authority: Respect the authority of coaches and officials, refraining from coaching from the sidelines or questioning officiating decisions during games, as outlined in <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s guidelines for parent behaviour.
  - Role Modelling: Serve as a positive role model for your child by demonstrating good sportsmanship, respect for others, and appropriate behaviour at all times, in accordance with <u>Basketball</u> <u>Victoria</u>'s expectations for parent conduct.
  - Communication: Communicate with coaches in a respectful and constructive manner, addressing any concerns or questions through appropriate channels and at appropriate times, following <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s guidelines for parent communication.
  - Cheering Responsibly: Cheer for all players and teams involved in the game, refraining from negative or derogatory comments towards opponents or officials, as outlined in <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s policies on parent conduct.
  - Emotional Control: Maintain emotional control during games, avoiding outbursts of anger or frustration that could create a negative atmosphere for players and spectators, in accordance with <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s expectations for parent behaviour.
  - Respect for Privacy: Respect the privacy and confidentiality of players and coaches, refraining from discussing sensitive or personal matters with other parents or spectators, as emphasised by <u>Basketball Victoria</u>'s policies on parent conduct.
